ABOUT OUR TREES & SHRUBS

The first trees were planted at this 140-acre arboretum in 1997. As of 2014 there are 2,200 trees and shrubs in the Arboretum's collections representing 468 species, hybrids and cultivars.

When trees and shrubs are planted at the Brenton Arboretum, a tag is attached including a botanical name and accession number. This number and information about seed source, planting date and growth habits are recorded in our database.

Look for the tree tags as you walk through the Arboretum. They will help you identify our trees and shrubs. Please contact the arboretum for information about newly-planted trees with temporary tags.

If you find a tree without a tag, please let us know. Most of the tree and shrub collections are planted informally in groups of the same species, allowing you to compare similar trees.



Accession number 2004-073 indicates that this tree was planted in 2004 and given the number 073.
